PLACEMAKING GRANT OBJECTIVES

To provide local organizations with funding to implement small impactful projects that encourage and contribute to a stronger sense of place.

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS

- Municipalities/Government organizations
- Non-profits

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS & DETAILS

- Projects must be impactful in placemaking
- Projects can range from physical upgrades to internal municipal system/process improvements
- Projects must be completed by September 4, 2020
- Projects should leverage additional resources

SELECTION & IMPLEMENTATION PROCESS

1. Complete the mini-grant application form by May 1, 2020
2. Application scoring by I-69 Thumb Region Partners
3. Winners announced June 1, 2020
4. Reimbursement requests submitted September 4, 2020
5. Reimbursement checks mailed out by September 30, 2020
